March 24, 1934: Philippine Islands were granted independence by Pres. Franklin D. Roosevelt after nearly 50 years of American control

March 1 1967: Peace Corps established by Pres. Kennedy, sending young American volunteers to developing countries to assist with health care, education and other basic human needs.

Mar. 18, 1974: Five-month-old Arab oil embargo against the U.S. was lifted. The embargo was in retaliation for our support of Israel during the Yom Kipper War. The embargo caused long lines at gas stations as prices soared 300 percent and the government banned Sunday gas sales..

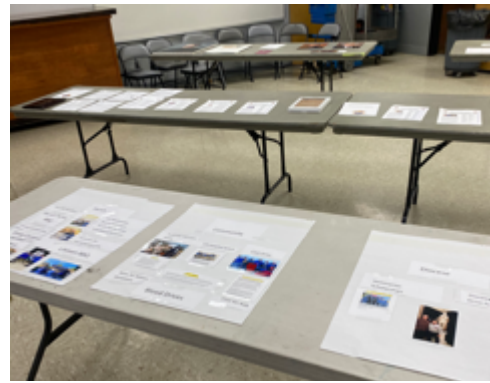

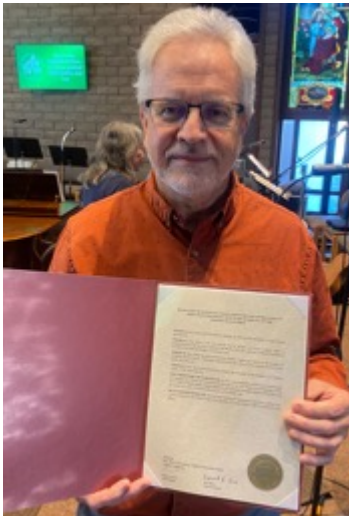

An Exemplification of the Patriotic Order will be on Saturday May 23, 2026 at St. Cabrini Parish in San Jose!! All Third Degree Knights are eligible and encouraged to move up to the Patriotic Order of the Knights. Applications are due no later than 30 days before the ceremony – i.e., April 23rd. An Initiation Fee is required and dress for the Exemplification will be announced later.

Why become a Patriotic Order Knight? **First**, this is the highest degree that you can attain. **Second**, this is the Patriotic Order, which honors our citizenship as Americans and emphasizes supporting our country and those who have served it. **Third**, it is the source of the Honor Guard (FKA: the Color Corps), the most visible arm of the Knights. **Finally**, you become a member of an Assembly consisting of four neighboring Councils. expanding your association with like-minded Knights from throughout the surrounding area parishes.
